### ADVOCACY TRAINING OPPORTUNITY

Effecting positive change does not always happen in Austin, it happens in our communities. The Arc of Texas Governmental Affairs Team will be providing **individualized/community based advocacy training** to create an advocacy "action plan" and provide support to chapters and interested community members.

Our goal is bigger than passing legislation during the 2017, 85th Legislative session. We are building a movement of people who understand and care about our issues (more people equals more power; power equals influence over the decision-maker). We want to engage communities (individuals with and without disabilities, media outlets, businesses, etc.) and build relationships with policy makers. Our plan is to train participants in both advocacy strategies and The Arc of Texas' policy priorities. We will assist participants in developing an advocacy "action plan". Finally, we will provide ongoing support and collaboration to help participants implement their "action plans". We will provide communities with all the tools necessary to be successful.
